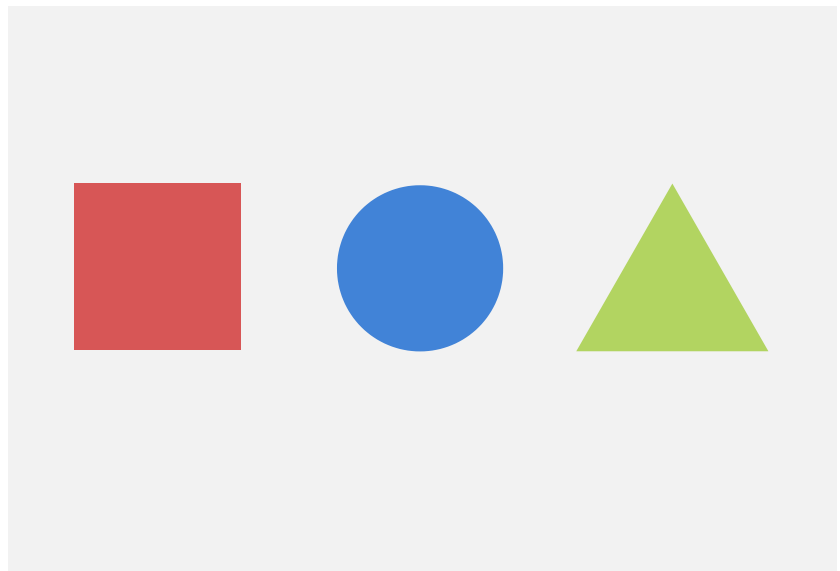
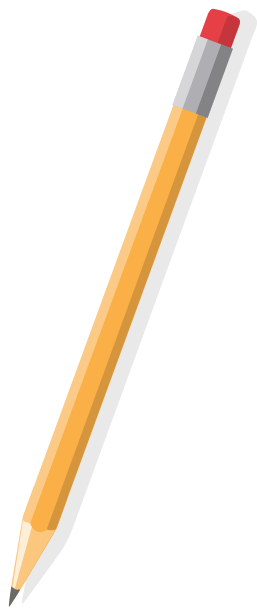


# Get Into● Sh▲pe

This is a really quick and creative way to test your class' understanding of a topic or a lesson. It can also be an activity to one back to throughout the year for pretty much any topic.

1. Instruct your class to draw a square, a circle or a triangle on a piece of paper, evenly spaced.



2. Ask your class to turn each shape into something that represents something they have learnt about that topic (the circle may become the body of Henry VIII, the triangle may become the top of Mount Everest, etc.) Be creative with it and enforce a time limit of five minutes.

3. Work in small groups to look at each other's ideas and ask questions.

Useful Tip: Use stamps of each shape to speed up the process. Stamping books with each shape in different colours is a great way to make the drawings more fun.
